- Bidding will start at the "start bid" amount and increase from there.
- The person with the highest bid... **CONGRATULATIONS** you have purchased a fleece!
- Please show auctioneers your bidder number.
- You can pay and collect your fleece(s) at the LMSPA cash desk at any time.
- Once paid, Fleece will be tagged and then we ask that you take them directly to your vehicle
- If a fleece has not been sold the first time through the auction we will auction it for a second time (unless
