### *Section 2 – FAQ's*

EVENT NAME: LMSPA- Sheep Matters: Farm to Community

LOCATION: Cloverdale Fairgrounds in the Alice McKay Building.  
6050 – 176 Street, Surrey, BC V3S 4E7.

DATE & TIME: Saturday, June 20, 2026. Open to Public from 10:00 am - 4:00 pm.

SET UP: Friday June 19 between 1pm-7pm OR Saturday June 20 between 8am – 9:50am.  
Absolutely NO setup after 10am on June 20th.

TAKE DOWN: **DO NOT TAKE DOWN BEFORE 4PM.**

SCHEDULE: Available on the website and for pickup at the Sale. Activities: viewing of judged fleece, LIVE fleece auction, Awards given & Artisan demo's.

PARKING: Free parking.

ADMISSION: Free admission.

BOOTH SPACE: One booth space is 10' deep x 10' wide. You may request more than one booth space. (2 booth spaces would be 10' deep x 20' wide.) A floor plan will be available closer to the date of the sale. There are no dividers between booths.

TABLES & CHAIRS: Are by request only. If you have your own set up we strongly encourage you to use it.

ELECTRICITY: Electricity is not available.

WIFI: There is Guest WIFI in the building but can be weak in certain areas of the building.

SECURITY: There will be 24 hour security on the Cloverdale Fairgrounds. The doors of the building will be locked after hours to keep your items safe.

FACILITIES: Wheelchair accessible and washrooms are available inside the building.

INSURANCE: Vendors are required to have proof of event insurance. If you do not carry such insurance, you can become an Associate Member of the LMSPA, for \$30 extra, and be covered under our liability policy for 1 year. This will ONLY cover you at LMSPA events. Vendors are responsible for his/her own goods. LMSPA will not be responsible for any theft, loss, or damage incurred by the Vendor to sale goods or personal effects.

### *Section 3 - Vendor Information*

#### BUSINESS:

1. The booth fee is due at time of reading, signing and returning of this Application Form. **Application deadline is May 20, 2026** to hold your space.
2. The Vendor will be allowed to sell only those items representative of his/her business, such as discussed/reviewed with LMSPA. Only items discussed at the time of application will be sold at your table
3. **DO NOT bring or sell raw or unprocessed Fleece** – this includes from **ALL** fibre animals.
4. The Vendor will not bring in any other seller or provider of goods at his/her table without the prior approval of LMSPA.
5. LMSPA reserves the right to final say in set-up, display and approval of all of the Vendors products.
6. The Vendor will be responsible for his/her own sales for the duration of the day.
7. The Vendor will be responsible for any special packaging necessary for his/her product.
8. The Vendor will be respectful to other Vendors and will not undercut, heavily discount or change prices on any of his/her goods for the duration of the sale. A discount bin is acceptable as long as it is set up at the beginning of the sale.
